PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-65617 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Kenneth E. Naas and Dorothy D. Naas of 27300 SE Fireman Way, Boring, Oregon 97009, phone 663-4209, for the construction of a reservoir, a tributary of North Fork Deep Creek, and storage of water from an unnamed stream to be appropriated under Application 65618, Permit 48009 for irrigation,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 2 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the County of Clackamas.

The maximum height will be 9.9 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.3 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 12.0 feet

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: Bottom width 3.0 feet, top width 4.0 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 3.0+ feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Stream flow, when running is around the reservoir not into it. A flume or pipe may be used when runoff is clear enough to add water with low levels of silt.

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.0 acre-foot

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is August 25, 1983

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 6, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.
