R-65617 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

Kenneth E. Nass and Dorothy D. Naas of 27300 SE Fireman Way, Boring, This permit is issued to Renneth E. Mass and Dorothy D. Mass of 27000 3E theman way, Dorong, Oregon 97009, phone 663-4209, for the construction of a reservoir, a tributary of North Fork Deep Creek, and storage of water from an unnamed stream to be appropriated under Application 65618, Permit 48009 for irrigation,

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 2 South, Range 3 East, WM. The dam will be LOCATED in the:
in the County of Clackamas.

The maximum height will be be 10.0 feet feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will face 3:1 and height of dam above water , slope of downstream face 2:1 , slope of upstream face , and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

0.3 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be $12.0\,$ feet The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: Bottom width 3.0 feet, top width 4.0 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 3.0+ feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Stream flow, when running is aroudn the reservoir not into it. A flume or pipe may be used when runoff is clear enough to add water with low levels of silt.

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.0 acre-foot

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 6, 1985 diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85
