PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **R-66008** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to **Eric S. Prior** on behalf of **Korru-tek (USA), Inc.**, 830 Signal Way, Coos Bay, Oregon 97420, phone 269-7556, for the construction of a reservoir, a tributary of Morgan Creek, and storage of water from Priorli Creek to be appropriated under Application 66009, Permit 48042 for fish culture,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: **SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 1, Township 26 South, Range 12 West, WM, in the County of Coos.**

The maximum height will be **n/a** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be **n/a**, slope of upstream face **n/a**, slope of downstream face **n/a**, and height of dam above water line when full **n/a**

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be **0.5 acre**, and the maximum depth of water will be **9.0 feet**

The locations and dimensions of the spillway are: **Bottom width 1.5 feet, top width 1.5 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 0.75 foot.**

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: **8 inch diameter pipe to Morgan Creek.**

The structure out of the channel.

The dam will be **dug out pond - off channel - flush with ground level, fed by 6 inch diameter pipe.**

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of **3.0 acre-feet**

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is **September 9, 1983**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **January 16, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1985**
