This permit is issued to United States, Fremont National Forest of PO Box 551, 34 North D Street, Lakeview, Oregon 97630, phone 947-2151, for the construction of a stock pond reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent stream, tributary to Thomas Creek for livestock and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the Water Resources Director to* The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 31, Township 37 South, Range 18 East, WM, in the County of Lake.
