## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

R--62105~ and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to USDA Forest Service, Malheur National Forest of 139 NE Dayton Street, John Day, Oregon 97845, phone 575-1731, for the construction of SW-20 Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent stream, tributary to Bear Creek for livestock and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, WM, in the County of Grant. evacuate the stored water when determined by the Water Resources Director to be necessary to\*

7.0 The maximum height will be feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet 2:1 , slope of downstream face 2:1 , slope of upstream face , and height of dam above water line when full 3.0

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.10 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 4.0 feet

## \* satisfy prior downstream rights.

The location and dimension of the spillway is: Around dam with a bottom width 8.0 feet, top width 12.0 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 3.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structure is in channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.16 acre-foot

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is August 3, 1981 for 0.06 af and April 1, 1983 for 0.10 af

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .
