PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-66727 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Finley McNaughton of 4401 London Drive, Parkdale, Oregon 97041, phone 352-7389, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from springs and runoff for recreation,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 17, Township 1 South, Range 10 East, WM, in the County of Hood River.

The maximum height will be 7.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 12.0 feet , slope of upstream face 1:1 , slope of downstream face 3:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 4.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.3 acre

, and the maximum depth of water will be 10.0 feet

The location and dimension of the spillway is: Around the dam, bottom width 12.0 feet, top width 14.0 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 2.5 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Outlet crosses south end of dam approximately 2.5 feet below top surface. Outlet is approximately 12.0 feet wide and is constructed to accomodate across-dam tractor or pickup transport. Outlet drains into Knight Creek (a tributary of East Fork of Hood River).

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.5 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 23, 1983.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **February 3, 1985** diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.
