PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **R-66716** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to **USDI, Bureau of Land Management of 3040 Biddle Road, Medford, Oregon 97504, phone 776-4174**, for the construction of Big Spring Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent stream, tributary to Johnson Creek, for livestock and wildlife,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: **SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 26, Township 38 South, Range 4 East, WM, in the County of Jackson.**

The maximum height will be **4.0** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be **10.0 feet**, slope of upstream face **1:1**, slope of downstream face **2:1**, and height of dam above water line when full **2.0 feet**

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be **0.04 acre**, and the maximum depth of water will be **3.0 feet**

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: **None.**

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: **An 18 inch culvert on the south side of the reservoir.**

The structure is in channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of **0.07 acre-foot**

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is **September 23, 1983**

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **February 13, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before **October 1, 1985**.
