PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION **R-67769** and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to **Elmer Stoller** of **505 Morrow Road, Independence, Oregon 97351**, phone **364-2570**, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from springs in reservoir to be appropriated under Application **67770**, Permit **48216** for irrigation,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: **SE 1/4 SW 1/4 and SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 29, Township 7 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Polk.**

The maximum height will be **9.5** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be **15.0 feet**, slope of upstream face **3:1**, slope of downstream face **3:1**, and height of dam above water line when full **3.0 feet**

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be **2.2 acres**, and the maximum depth of water will be **14.0 feet**

The location and dimension of the spillway is: The bottom width of the spillway will be **6.0 feet**. The top width of the spillway will be **10.0 feet**. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be **3.0 feet**.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduits will be: **6 inch steel pipe through base of dam with 6 inch gate valve.**

The structure is in channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of **9.0 acre-feet**

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is **October 13, 1983**.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before **February 21, 1985**, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 **85**.
