PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-67549 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to J. Thomas Wilds of PO Box 553/2145 Star Route, Mosier, Oregon 97040, phone 248-8332, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from intermittent runoff for stock water

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

The maximum height will be 7.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 4.0 feet , slope of upstream face 3:1 , slope of downstream face 2:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 4.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.7 acre , and the maximum of

, and the maximum depth of water will be 5.0 feet

The location and dimension of the spillway is: Around the dam, bottom width 3.0 foot, top width 4.0 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 3.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: Two (2) 6 inch drain pipes at 4.0 feet below top level on pond side, Plus an overflow spill way of 3.0 feet width 3 1/2 feet below dam top.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 2.0 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 12, 1983 .

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1985 diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.
