PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-67776 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to M.D. Martin, President, Omega Factors, of 11825 SW Greenburg Road, Tigard, Oregon 97223, phone 639-8812, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream to be appropriated under Application 67777, Permit 48264, for irrigation and emergency fire protection,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Washington.

The maximum height will be 9.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 8.0 feet , slope of upstream face 3:1 , slope of downstream face 2:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 4.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.0 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 5.0 feet

The location and dimension of the spillway is: None.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: 30 inch CMP, 60 feet in length with slide gate.

The structure is out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 5.0 acre-feet, being 4.0 af for irrigation and 1.0 af for fire protection

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is 0ctober 14, 1983.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 6, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19.85 .
