## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-67891 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to James T. Ernest of 34109 Johnson Landing Road, Scappoose, Oregon 97056, phone 543-6036, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed drainage way ditch to be appropriated under Application 67890, Permit 48265, for irrigation. All flashboards to be removed from spillway during the period from October 1 to April 1 of each year.

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 18, Township 3 North, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Columbia.

The maximum height will be 8.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be n/a, slope of upstream face n/a, slope of downstream face n/a, and height of dam above water line when full 2.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.55 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 6.0 feet

The location and dimension of the spillway is: Around the dam, bottom width 8.0 feet, top width 8.0 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 2.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: 16 inch cmp conduit located under center of the dam.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 4.9 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 14, 1983 .

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 6, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985 .
