PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-67710 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to J. John Burbank of 2285 State Road, Mosier, Oregon 97040, phone 298-1031, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from snowmelt and runoff for stockwater,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 21, Township 2 North, Range 12 East, WM, in the County of Wasco.

The maximum height will be 9.9 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 12.0 feet , slope of upstream face 2:1 , slope of downstream face 3:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.3 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 8.0 feet

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Around the dam, the bottom width of the spillway will be 10.0 feet, the top width of the spillway will be 24.0 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 6.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structure is in channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 1.5 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is February 8, 1984.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 9, 1985 diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.
