

Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Willard L. Benson (Name of Applicant)

of Silverton Star Route (Mailing Address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Willard's Pool

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is Powers Creek

tributary of Pudding River

3. The amount of water to be stored is 375 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is Fish culture (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 15 - 22 (Give sections or townships to be submerged)

Tp. 7 S, R. 1 E, W. M., in the county of Marion

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet in channel

6. The dam will be located in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 & SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Sec. 15 (Smallest legal subdivision)

Tp. 7 S, R. 1 E, W. M. The maximum height will be 40 feet above stream bed or ground

surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 330 feet; length on

bottom 85 feet; width on top 20 feet; slope of front

or water side 3:1; slope on back 2:1; height of dam above water line (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical)

when full 8 feet.
