PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-67918 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Harry Strain of 47721 Floras Lake Loop, Langlois, Oregon 97450, phone 348-2489, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream and Jim Creek, a tributary of Floras Creek to be appropriated under Application 67919, Permit 48298 for irrigation stockwater,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SE $1/4\,$ NW $1/4\,$ of Section 10, Township 31 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the County of Curry.

The maximum height will be n/a feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be n/a , slope of upstream face n/a , slope of downstream face n/a , and height of dam above water line when full n/a

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.1 acre , and the maximum depth of water will be 9.0 feet

* (0.225 af for irrigation and 0.025 af for stock)

The location and dimension of the spillway is: None.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: 18 inch metal culvert.

The structure out of the channel.

The reservoir will be a dug pond.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.5 acre-foot, being 0.25 af from unnamed stream (0.225 af for irrigation and 0.025 af for stock) and 0.25 af from Jim Creek * The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is 0ctober 14, 1983

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 16, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85.
