This permit is issued to 97720, phone 573-5241, for the construction of 5124-Definite Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream, a tributary to Rattlesnake Creek for livestock and wildlife and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when *
