PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-66185 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to District Manager, Bureau of Land Management of 74 Alvord Avenue, Burns, Oregon 97720, phone 573-5241, for the construction of 5194-Waterbuck Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed stream, for livestock and wildlife and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the Water Resources *

The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 25 South, Range 35 East, WM, in the County of Harney.

The maximum height will be 15.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 8.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0.5 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 12.0 feet

* Director to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Around the dam, bottom width 6.0 feet, top width 12.0 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 3.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structure is in channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 4.0 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 19, 1983.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 26, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.
