PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-60207 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Crystal Springs Packing Co., c/o Duane Culbertson of 327 S. Fir Street, Medford, Oregon 97501, phone 772-4298, for the construction of Crestbrook Upper Reservoir, tributary of Bear Creek, and storage of water from an unnamed stream with any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed stream to be made up by diversion from Mud Creek, to be appropriated under Application 60208, *

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 27, Township 37 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

The maximum height will be 20.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 2.8 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.845 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 17.2 feet

* Permit 48400, for temperature control,

The location and dimension of the spillway is: Around the west end of the dam. The bottom width of the spillway will be 5.9 feet; the top width of the spillway will be 5.9 feet; and the distance between the crest of the spillway will be 2.8 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: A 30 inch diameter CMP pipeline with gatevalave though bottom at SW corner of dam.

The structure out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 20.0 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is May 30, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 7, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.
