## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-67452 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Eleanore and Kenneth Purdy of PO Box 4429, Medford, Oregon 97501, phone 772-2563, for the construction of a reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed drainageway to be appropriated under Application 67453, Permit 48421 for frost control,

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 38 South, Range 1 West, WM, in the County of Jackson.

The maximum height will be 8.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 10.0 feet, slope of upstream face 3:1, slope of downstream face 2:1, and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 2.1 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 8.0 feet

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Around the dam, bottom width 10.0 feet, top width 22.0 feet, the distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway 3.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: 4 inch PVC pipe, 34 feet long located in center of dam face.

The structure out of the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 9.1 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 10, 1983

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 14, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986
