Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir and to Store for Beneficial Use the Unappropriated Waters of the State of Oregon

I, A. E. Brockway (Name of Applicant)

of Medford 2325 Stewart Avenue (Mailing Address)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to construct the following described reservoir and to store the unappropriated waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights.

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The name of the proposed reservoir is Brockway Reservoir

2. The name of the stream from which the reservoir is to be filled and the appropriation made is none - filled by three springs tributary of Antelope Creek Watershed

3. The amount of water to be stored is 1.7 acre feet.

4. The use to be made of the impounded water is irrigation (Irrigation, power, domestic supply, etc.)

5. The location of the proposed reservoir will be in Sec. 18 (Give sections or townships to be submerged) Tp. 36 S., R. 1 E., W. M., in the county of Jackson

(a) State whether situated in channel of running stream and give character of material at outlet Reservoir built to cover marshland. Not in running stream. Material black sticky.

(b) If not in channel of running stream, state how it is to be filled. If through a feed canal, give name and dimensions Fed by three springs through ditches

6. The dam will be located in SW 1/4 NE 1/4 (Smallest legal subdivision), Sec. 18, Tp. 36 S., R. 1 E., W. M. The maximum height will be 3.5 feet above stream bed or ground surface on center line of dam. The length on top will be 250 feet; length on bottom same feet; width on top 20 feet; slope of front or water side 3 to 1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); slope on back 2 to 1 (Feet horizontal to 1 vertical); height of dam above water line when full 1. feet.

* A different form of application should be used for the appropriation of stored water to beneficial use. Such forms can be secured without charge, together with instructions, by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

7. The construction of dam, the material of which it is to be built, and method of protection from waves are as follows: Material from locality. Protected by adequate spillway.

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8. The location of wasteway with dimensions are as follows: around dam
(State whether over or around the dam)

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9. The location of outlet from the proposed reservoir, with character of construction and dimensions, are as follows: 12" tile through dam to flush out only water to be pumped
(State whether through or around the proposed dam)

from storage to use.
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10. The area submerged by the proposed reservoir, when full, will be 9/10 acres, with a maximum depth of water of 2.5 feet; and approximate mean depth of water 2 feet.

11. The estimated cost of the proposed work is \$ 800.00

12. Construction work will begin on or before 1 yr. from date of priority

13. Construction work will be completed on or before 2 yrs. from date of priority
