## PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-64817 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Metropolitan Wastewater Management Commission (MWMC) of 225 North 5th Street, Suite 292, Springfield, Oregon 97477, phone 747-4551, for the construction of a reservoir, a tributary to Willamette River and storage of wastewater to be appropriated under Application 64818, Permit 48474 for irrigation of crops for disposal of cannery wastewater, and the dam shall be constructed under\* The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27, NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 34, Township 16 South, Range 4 West, WM, in the County of Lane.

The maximum height will be 15.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 14.0 feet , slope of upstream face 2.5:1 , slope of downstream face 2.0:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 2.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 14.0~acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 19.0~feet

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 230.2 acre-feet
