PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-68053 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Garrett Van Diest, Inc., of PO Box 867, Winnemucca, Nevada 89445, phone (702)623-3097, for the construction of a reservoir, a tributary of Luckiamute River, and storage of water from an unnamed stream when available with any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed stream to be made up by appropriation from Pedee Creek to be appropriated under Application 48512, Permit 48448 for irrigation, The dam will be LOCATED in the: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32, Township 9 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the County of Polk.

The maximum height will be n/a feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be n/a, slope of upstream face n/a, slope of downstream face n/a, and height of dam above water line when full n/a

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1.2 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 9.0 feet

The location and dimension of the spillway is: None.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structure is out of the channel.

The reservoir will be excavated or dug out entirely below the ground surface. It will be rectangular in shape. 180 feet wide by 300 feet long and 9.0 feet deep. The side slopes will be 2:1. There will be no water storage above the ground surface.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 8.8 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is April 10, 1984

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 13, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1986.
