PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-67960 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Brocks Resources Investment Corporation of PO Box 6119, Bend, Oregon 97708, phone 382-1662, for the construction of Mitchell Ranch Reservoir Enlargement and storage of water from Bear Creek and Bridge Creek, tributaries of John Day River, to be appropriated under Application 67961, Permit 48540 for irrigation and supplemental irrigation, and the dam shall be constructed under the * The dam will be LOCATED in the: NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 10 South, Range 20 East, WM, in the County of Wheeler.

The maximum height will be 40.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 160.0 feet , slope of upstream face 3:1 , slope of downstream face 2:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 9.4 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 65.0 acres, and the maximum depth of water will be 30.0+ feet

* supervision of a registered professional engineer,

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Around the dam, the bottom width of the spillway will be 28.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 46.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 9.4 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: The outlet conduit is through Dam 1. It is an 18 inch corrugated metal pipe with a slidegate.

The structure is out the channel.

The dam will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 490.0 acre-feet, being 160.0 af from Bear Creek and 330.0 af from Bridge Creek
The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is October 17, 1983.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 19, 1985 , and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 86 .
