

PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

R-68126 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to Greatwest Agricorp Inc., adb Paradise Ranch Inn of 7000 Monument Drive, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, phone 479-4333, for the construction of Deer Lake Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed drainageway and Laurel Pond Reservoir and Harris Pond Reservoir and storage of water from a man-made creek, the three reservoirs to be maintained by appropriation under Applications 68127 and * The dam will be LOCATED in the: Deer Lake - SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14 and NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 23; Laurel Pond - SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 14 and NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 23; Harris Pond - NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 23, all within Township 35 ** The maximum height will be n/a feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be n/a , slope of upstream face n/a , slope of downstream face \(1/a \) , and height of dam above water line when full n/a

The location and dimensions of the spillway are: Deer Lake - at west side, bottom width 16.0 feet, top width 28.0 feet; depth 2.0 feet; Laurel Pond - at south side, bottom width 7.0 feet, depth 2.0 feet; Harris Pond - at south side, bottom width 13.0 feet, top width 21.0 feet, depth 4.0 feet.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 52.4 acre-feet, being 32.6 af in Deer Lake Reservoir, 11.1 af in Laurel Pond Reservoir, 8.7 af in Harris Pond Reservoir The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is July 20, 1984

July 30, 1985 Actual construction work shall begin on or before and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .
