United States, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath This permit is issued to United States, Winema National Forest of PO Box 1390, Klamath Falls, Oregon 97601, phone 883-6714, for the construction of Rocky Hole Reservoir, Grouse Spring Reservoir and an unnamed reservoir, and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent stream, a tributary of Sprague River for livestock, and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other * The dam will be LOCATED in the: Reservoir 1 - NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9; Reservoir 2 - SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 16; Reservoir 3 - SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, all in Township 35 South, Range 8 East, WM, in the County of Klamath.

The maximum height will be ** feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will , slope of upstream face 3:1 , slope of downstream face 2:1 , and height of dam above water line when full Reservoir 1 - 3.0 feet; Reservoir 2 - 3.0 feet; Reservoir 3 - 0.0 feet

, and the maximum depth of water will be Reservoir The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 1 - 6.0 feet; Reservoir 2 - 4.0 feet; Reservoir 3 - 5.0 feet

- means to evacuate the stored water when determined by the Water Resources Director to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The locations and dimensions of the spillways are: Around the dam, the bottom width of the spillways will be Reservoir 1 - 8.0 feet; Reservoir 2 - 3.0 feet. The top width of the spillways will be Reservoir 1-10.0 feet; Reservoir 2-5.0 feet. The distance between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillways will be Reservoir 1 - 2.0 feet; Reservoir 2 - 3.0 feet.

The locations and dimensions of the cutlet conduits will be: None.

The structures are in the channel.

The dams will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.45 acre-foot, being 0.20 af in Rocky Hole Reservoir, 0.20 af in Grouse Spring Reservoir and 0.05 af in unnamed reservoir. The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is March 18, 1983

August 14, 1985 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable Actual construction work shall begin on or before diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 85 .
