PERMIT to CONSTRUCT a RESERVOIR and to STORE for BENEFICIAL USE the PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION R-62941 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS AND THE FOLLOWING LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS:

This permit is issued to United States Forest Service, Mt. Hood National Forest of 2955 NW Division Street, Gresham, Oregon 97030, phone 667-0511, for the construction of Bobcat Pond Reservoir and storage of water from an unnamed intermittent stream, a tributary of Eightmile Creek, for livestock and wildlife, and is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to *

The dam will be LOCATED in the: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 1, Township 2 South, Range 11 East, W M, in the County of Wasco.

The maximum height will be 6.0 feet above the stream bed or ground surface at the centerline. The top width will be 8.0 feet , slope of upstream face 3:1 , slope of downstream face 2:1 , and height of dam above water line when full 3.0 feet

The area submerged by the reservoir, when full, will be 0,322 acre, and the maximum depth of water will be 6.0 feet

* evacuate the stored water when determined by the Water Resources Director to be necessary to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The location and dimension of the spillway are: Around the dam, the bottom width of the spillway will be 3.0 feet. The top width of the spillway will be 5.6 feet. The distances between the crest of the dam and the crest of the spillway will be 3.0 feet.

The location and dimension of the outlet conduit will be: None.

The structure is in the channel.

The dams will be earthfill construction.

The right hereunder shall be limited to the storage of 0.97 acre-feet

The PRIORITY DATE of this permit is September 13, 1983.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 27, 1985, and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1985.
