

## \*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

## To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Everett A. Johnson (Name of applicant)  
of Portland (Postoffice), County of Multnomah,  
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the  
following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Bluejay Creek (Name of stream)  
a tributary of ogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.5  
cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and irrigation  
(Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 200 ft. S. and 100 ft. E. from the NW  
corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  (Lot 6) of Sec. 12, Tp. 35 S., R. 12 W. W. M.  
(Section or subdivision)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Bluejay Creek, tributary of Rogue River

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic and irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 5, 1931

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 19, 1932 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1933

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1934
