

\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Sam Elmer (Name of applicant) of Mulino (Postoffice), County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed stream, trib. Mud Creek (Name of stream) trib. Mill Creek, a tributary of Molalla River.

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.5 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is maintenance of ponds for fish, frogs and fur bearing animals. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 355 ft. N. and 255 ft. E from the 1/4 Sec. corner of Between 19 & 20, T. 4 S., R. 3 E. (Section or subdivision)

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream, tributary of Mud Creek, trib. of Mill Creek, trib. of Molalla River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is maintenance of ponds for fish, frogs and fur bearing animals.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 11, 1931

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 19, 1932 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1933

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1934
