

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, T. H. Sherrard, Forest Supervisor, Mount Hood National Forest
(Name of applicant)

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed spring, trib. of Swim Cr., trib. of Still Cr., of Zigzag River, tributary of Sandy River, of the Columbia River
(Name of stream)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one (1) cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic supplies
(Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located Bears S 39° E, 955 feet from the section corner common to Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24, T. 3 S., R. 8½ E. W.M.

5. The pipeline to be 425 feet miles in length, terminating in the SW of NW of Sec. 24, Tp. 3 S, R. 8½ E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

STATE OF OREGON, County of Marion, ss.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of 0.10 second-foot of water from an unnamed spring, tributary of Swim Creek, for domestic use.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.1 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is January 19, 1931

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 3, 1932 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1933

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1934
