

* APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Warren H. Bailey (Name of applicant) of Carlton (Postoffice), County of Yamhill, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Spring (unnamed) (Name of stream), a tributary of Panther Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.1 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

4. The point of diversion is located 1370 ft. South and 390 ft. West from the N.E. corner of Section 20. (Section or subdivision)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed spring, tributary of Panther Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 21, 1931.....
