This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,
subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited

to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject
to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of 0.006 second-foot
of water from an unnamed spring, tributary of Yachats Bay, for domestic, including
garden irrigation.

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to bene-
ficial use and not to exceed 0.006 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of
rotation. The priority date of this permit is June 18, 1932

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 5, 1933 and shall
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
Oct. 1, 1934

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before
Oct. 1, 1935
