*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, U. S. Forest Service, by G. E. Mitchell, Forest Supervisor of Grants Pass, County of Josephine, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Store Gulch, a tributary of Illinois River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.1 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supply

4. The point of diversion is located 0 ft. N. or S and 1345 ft. east from the NW corner of Sec. 3, Twp. 38 S., R. 9 W.W.M.

being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 38 S, R. 9 W., W. M., in the county of Josephine

5. The main ditch and pipe line to be 1600 ft. in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 3, Tp. 38 S, R. 9 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Store Gulch, tributary of Illinois River

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to *** of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 25, 1932

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 10, 1933 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1934 Extended to Oct. 1, 1935 Extended to Oct. 1, 1936
