This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,
subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use
and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet measured at the point of diversion from the stream,
water users, from an unnamed tributary of Cunniff Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to * * * of one cubic foot per
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system
as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 16, 1932

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 18, 1934 and shall
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
Oct. 1, 1935
