*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Mrs. H. L. Carl of Hubbard, County of Marion, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Pudding River, a tributary of Willamette

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.25 cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation

4. The point of diversion is located 50 ft. S and 600 ft. E from the SW corner of Sec. 2 & also along stream thruout sections 2, 10 & 11 where stream passes thru property of applicant

being within the S 1/2 Sec. 2, N 1/2 Sec. 10 of Sec. 11, Tp. 5 S R. 1 W, W. M., in the county of Marion

5. The no permanent ditches to be in length, terminating in the of Sec. Tp. R., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.25 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Pudding River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 16, 1933

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 20, 1934 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1935

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1936 Extended to Oct. 1, 1937
