

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Fred W. Nelson (Name of applicant) of Unity (Postoffice), County of Baker, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Drainage from SE 1/4, NE 1/4, Section 23, and NW 1/4 Section 24, a tributary of Bull Run Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 60 inches cubic feet per second.

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic

4. The point of diversion is located 660 ft. S and 750 ft. E from the NW corner of Sec. 24 - is near center of NW 1/4, NW 1/4 OF sec. 24.

being within the NW 1/4, NW 1/4 of Sec. 24, Tp. 13 S, R. 36 E, W. M., in the county of Baker

5. The ditch to be used 1500 in length, terminating in the SE 1/4, SW 1/4 & SW 1/4, SW 1/4 of Sec. 13, Tp. 13 S, R. 36 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

\$14.50 PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use measured at the point of diversion from the stream, and shall not exceed 0.55 cubic feet per second/or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Drainage

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40 of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, shall not exceed three acre feet per acre during the irrigation season from April 1, to October 1, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 7, 1933

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 28, 1934 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1935

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1936
