To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Edith M. Bell Hill (Name of applicant)

of Bonneville (Postoffice), County of Multnomah

State of Oreg., do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Columbia River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.0 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic and supply for camps and businesses which may be established. (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam None feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed creek, tributary of Columbia River.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic and supply for camps and businesses which may be established.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 6, 1933

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 26, 1935 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1936

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1937
