

**\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT**

**To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon**

I, W. J. Smith (Name of applicant)  
of Gold Hill (Postoffice), County of Jackson,  
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the  
following described public waters of the State of Oregon, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:**

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is W and E Forks Sardine Creek (Name of stream)  
a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.25  
cubic feet per second. from W. Fork and 0.25 from South Fork of Sardine Creek  
(If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation  
(Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 50 ft. N and 50 ft. E from the 1/4  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)  
corner of between Sections 29 and 32, from W. Fork, and 300 feet N. and 1300 feet E.  
(Section or subdivision)  
of 1/4 corner between Sections 28 and 29, from E. Fork of Sardine Creek  
(If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 29 and SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 28, Tp. 35 S,

**DESCRIPTION OF WORKS**

**DIVERSION WORKS—**

(a) Height of dam 4 feet, length on top L 25 feet, length at bottom R 40 feet,  
12 feet; material to be used and character of construction pole, rock and dirt  
(Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate direct into ditch from creek  
(Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description  
(Size and type of pump)

(Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

\* A different form of application is provided where storage works are contemplated.

\*\* Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

**PERMIT**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from 0.25 sec. ft. each from  
West and South Forks of Sardine Creek, tributary of Rogue River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per  
second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 13, 1934

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 24, 1935 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before  
Oct. 1, 1936

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before  
Oct. 1, 1937
