

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Tom Wharton (Name of applicant) of Roseburg (Postoffice), County of Douglas, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is unnamed stream (Name of stream), a tributary of North Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.01 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is domestic supplies (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located ft. and 310 ft. W from the SE corner of NE 1/4 SE 1/4 (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary.) being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 10, Tp. 26 S, R. 3 W, W. M., in the county of Douglas (Give smallest legal subdivision) (E. or W.)

5. The pipe line (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 800 ft. (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 10, Tp. 26 S, R. 3 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

PERMIT

STATE OF OREGON, ss. County of Marion,

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use measured at the point of diversion from the stream, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second/or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream,

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is February 9, 1934

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 24, 1935 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1936

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1937
