

\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Fred Bauer (Name of applicant) of Dayton, Route 1 (Postoffice), County of Yamhill, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed stream & Aquatic Lake (Name of stream), a tributary of Aquatic Lake

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 3.0 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is supply lake for raising water lilies (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

**PERMIT**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from  
Unnamed stream and Aquatic Lake

The use to which this water is to be applied is to supply lake for raising water lilies

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per  
second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 3, 1934

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 26, 1935 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before  
Oct. 1, 1936

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before  
Oct. 1, 1937
