

\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 11792

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Hans M. Hansen (Name of applicant)

of Long Creek (Postoffice), County of Grant

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is a spring (Name of stream), a tributary of Long Creek, a trib. of John Day River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.2 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1840 ft. South (N. or S.) and ft. East (E. or W.) from the E 1/4 corner of Section 4, Tp. 10 S., R. 30 E.W.M. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

\$9.50 PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic feet per second, measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from A spring, tributary of Long Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

This appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated prior to June 1, and thereafter 1/80th of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent, shall not exceed one acre foot per acre during any month prior to June 1, nor exceed a total during the irrigation season from April 1, to September 30, of each year of four acre feet per acre and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 29, 1933

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 17, 1935 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1936

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1937
