

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Basil Serban (Name of applicant) of Route 1, Box 86, Sandy (Postoffice), County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed stream (Name of stream), a tributary of the Sandy River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is less than 1 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation and domestic supply (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 100 ft. S and 55 ft. E from the NW corner of the North Half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 1, Township 2 South, Range 4 East of the Willamette Meridian (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the N 1/2 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 1, Tp. 2 S, R. 4 E, W. M., in the county of Clackamas (Give smallest legal subdivision) (E. or W.)

5. The main ditch to be 350 feet (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the N 1/2 SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 1, Tp. Two (10), R. Four (4) EW. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam 5 feet, length on top 25 feet, length at bottom 15 feet; material to be used and character of construction Timber crib filled with loose earth and rock (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate 1 gate, 2' x 3' constructed from timber (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description (Size and type of pump) (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

an unnamed stream, tributary of Sandy River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, or each acre irrigated,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 31, 1934

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 17, 1935 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1936

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1937
