

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Stanley S. Anderson (Name of applicant) of Marial (Postoffice), County of Curry, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Price Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Mule Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is .067 cu. ft. cubic feet per second. or 4 cu. ft. per minute total (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.

4. The point of diversion is located 1720 ft. S and 2013 ft. W from the NE corner of Section 9 (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam 9 feet, length on top 26 feet, length at bottom 5 feet; material to be used and character of construction concrete and steel (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate Concrete 2 only 6" openings (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

(c) If water is to be pumped give general description gravity (Size and type of pump) (Size and type of engine or motor to be used, total head water is to be lifted, etc.)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.067 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Price Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 8, 1934

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 17, 1935 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1936

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1937
