*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, F. J. O'Connor (Name of applicant) of Galice (Postoffice), County of Josephine, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Applegate Gulch (Name of stream), a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2.0 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is mining and domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1100 ft. S and 900 ft. E from the NW 1/4 corner of section 35, T. 34 S., R. 8 W.W.M. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described. Use separate sheet if necessary) being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 34 S, R. 8 W., W. M., in the county of Josephine (Give smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

5. The ditch (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 1 1/2 miles (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 (Lot 10) of Sec. 36, Tp. 34 S, R. 8 W., W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam 6 feet, length on top 12 feet, length at bottom 4 feet; material to be used and character of construction Log crib dam. Wasteway over. (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Applegate Gulch

The use to which this water is to be applied is mining and domestic

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 30, 1934

Actual construction work shall begin on or before December 28, 1935 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
