 following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rock Creek

Tributary of Devils Lake, a tributary of Pacific Ocean

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 5

## DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

## DIVERSION WORKS—

25 feet; material to be used and character of construction timber, rock crib and  
concrete  
(Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 5.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from  
Rock Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Domestic and municipal use

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per  
second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 28, 1933

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 30, 1936 and shall  
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before  
Oct. 1, 1937

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before  
Oct. 1, 1938
