\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, I. L. Stout (Name of applicant) of Boardman (Postoffice), County of Morrow, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Waste water unnamed (Name of stream), a tributary of Lake-unnamed

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 2 to 6 acre-ft cubic feet per second. Requirement about 6 acre feet (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 6 ft. N and 2043 ft. E from the S.W. corner of Section 7. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

5. The pipe to be 100 ft. in length, terminating in the SW 1/4 of Sec. 7, Tp. 4 N, R. 25 E, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) (Miles or feet) (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

6. (a) Height of dam feet, length on top feet, length at bottom feet; material to be used and character of construction (Loose rock, concrete, masonry, rock and brush, timber crib, etc., wasteway over or around dam)

(b) Description of headgate Concrete 2 ft. wide 18 in. high (Timber, concrete, etc., number and size of openings)

\*\* Applications for permits to appropriate water for the generation of electricity, with the exception of municipalities, must be made to the Hydroelectric Commission. Either of the above forms may be secured, without cost, together with instructions by addressing the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon.

**PERMIT**

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same,  
subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use  
and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the  
stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Waste water

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/60th of one cubic foot per  
seconds or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reason-  
able rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer, and is also limited  
to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and does not carry with it the  
right to require the wasteful use of water by others.
