*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Robert L. Taylor (Name of applicant) of 220 1/2 Laurel St., Medford (Postoffice), County of Jackson, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Little Applegate (Name of stream) tributary of Big Applegate River, a tributary of Rogue River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.0 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is mining and domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 50 ft. South and 1325 ft. West (N. or S.) (E. or W.) from the North 1/4 corner of Section 31, diversions to be continuous between these points to facilitate work. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from

Little Applegate River

The use to which this water is to be applied is mining and domestic, being 0.99 sec. ft. for mining and 0.01 sec. ft. for domestic purposes.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 31, 1935

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 10, 1936 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1937

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1938
