

**\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT**

**To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon**

I, Marion R. McCrae (Name of applicant)  
of Wallowa (Postoffice), County of Wallowa,  
State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the  
following described public waters of the State of Oregon, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:**

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

Wm. Womack ranch, a tributary of Wallowa River

**DIVERSION WORKS—**

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Springs and seepage water

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to a diversion of of one cubic foot per second not to exceed 1 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during any 30-day period from May 1, to July 31, and thereafter shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during the remainder of the irrigation season ending October 1, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 12, 1935

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 31, 1936 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1937

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1938
