\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Fred Wollenberg (Name of applicant) of 562 Mission St., San Francisco (Postoffice), County of California, State of California, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Cow Creek (Name of stream), a tributary of South Umpqua River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 1.125 cubic feet per second. (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.125 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Cow Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is Irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/70th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1, to October 1, of each year,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 25, 1935

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 10, 1937 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before
