

\*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

CERTIFICATE NO. 13705

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Antone H. Evers (Name of applicant) of Forest Grove (Postoffice), County of Washington State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is drainage Ditch No. 7 and Dairy Creek (Name of stream) branch, a tributary of Dairy Creek

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is cubic feet per second. Irrigation of forty acres with overhead system (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

\*\*3. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located 1700 ft. N and 1000 ft. W from the SE corner of Section 13, Township 1 N., Range 4 W. 330' S - 92.5' E from center of Sec. 13. See letter 7/30/36 & reply. (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to existing rights and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Drainage Ditch No. 7 and Dairy Creek branch, being 0.25 sec. ft. from each source

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 23, 1936

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 29, 1937 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1938 Extended to Oct. 1, 1939

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1939
