APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON

State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: The priority date of this permit is March 16, 1912
