

*APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, Southern Pacific Company (Name of applicant) of Portland (Postoffice), County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon, subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is an unnamed creek (Name of stream), a tributary of Nehalem River

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.3 cubic feet per second. one source only (If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

**3. The use to which the water is to be applied is railroad and domestic (Irrigation, power, mining, manufacturing, domestic supplies, etc.)

4. The point of diversion is located ft. and ft. from the corner of S. 73 10' E 2172 ft. from West 1/4 sec. cor. of Section 31, T. 3 N., R. 5 W. (Section or subdivision) (If preferable, give distance and bearing to section corner)

5. The pipe line (Main ditch, canal or pipe line) to be 3.6 miles (Miles or feet) in length, terminating in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 27, Tp. 3 N, R. 5 W, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map. (Smallest legal subdivision) (N. or S.) (E. or W.)

DIVERSION WORKS—

PERMIT

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.3 cubic feet per second/ or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is railroad and domestic purposes

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 2, 1936

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 29, 1937 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before Oct. 1, 1938

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before Oct. 1, 1939
